2008-2009 DAVID L. ANGUS INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL FUND**

**Purpose of the Award**

The David L. Angus International Travel Fund was established to honor the memory of David Angus, a professor in the School of Education from 1966 until his death in 1999. A distinguished historian of American education, David was also deeply involved in research and teaching in the areas of comparative and international education.

The purpose of this award is to support Ph.D. candidates doing research in the areas of international or comparative education. The award (up to a maximum of \$500) will support work in the 2008-2009 academic year, and funds can be used to pay for travel outside North America related to dissertation research on an international or comparative topic, or for the presentation of dissertation-based research on an international or comparative topic at an international conference. Students will receive half of the award as a travel advance prior to the trip, and will receive the remaining half upon returning and providing a brief report of the work done and a copy of the receipt for airfare.

**Eligibility**

Applicants must have achieved candidacy, and must use the funds to support travel associated with dissertation-related research in comparative education or in an international setting. Students who receive the Angus Award are still eligible for funds from other University sources such as the Rackham travel grants and the Deans' Office travel funds.

**Application Process: ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION IS REQUIRED via <http://sitemaker.soe.umich.edu/soe.awards/home> Click on the "Students" link and complete the cover sheet by entering all required information. *Be sure to include the name of the faculty member who will write a letter of support.* Then submit the remainder of your application **IN ONE DOCUMENT** (either .doc or .pdf) using the link on the cover sheet. Your application document should contain the following components:**

- **A description (no more than 750 words) of the research project**
- **An estimate of travel costs for which this award is sought**
- **A current curriculum vitae**

**Review Process**

All applications will be reviewed by the Graduate Affairs Committee (GAC) soon after the application deadline, and applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision. As funds are limited, only a small number of awards can be made each year.
