

Latin: MAJOR Requirements for Secondary Teacher Certification

These requirements are for students entering the program in summer 2008 or later.

Major/minor requirements are subject to change. All candidates are expected to consult with a School of Education advisor as they plan and progress through their program. In addition, candidates are responsible for checking with departments about possible prerequisites/co-requisites for non-Education courses required by their major/minor.
